Speaker: Allison Byrne, Executive Director, Allies for Teens in Foster Care

Allies for Teens in Foster Care helps the hundreds of Milwaukee County teens who live in the over 40 group homes in Milwaukee County. Allies is a bridge for the community to help our most vulnerable teenagers, with programs the promote the long-term health of teens, including self-care programs, corporate partnerships, advocacy and holiday care packages.

The Executive Director of Allies, Allison Byrne, is a licensed Social Worker and has a Masters in Cultural Foundation of Education. She is the proud mother of four, two biological and two adopted children. Before she had the privilege of adopting one of her children when her daughter was eight, she was her foster mother for almost a year. Ms. Byrne has been a child advocate for over a decade. She has firsthand experience with beautiful children struggling with RAD, trauma, neurological challenges and other impediments to child happiness. She is a first-generation college student, who grew up in Queens, NY.

Ms. Byrne is a twice elected alderwoman for the city of Wauwatosa. She also is a Foster Care ambassador for Children's Hospital of Wisconsin.

Helen Ludwig is handling reservations and defined the concept of:


- "Standing" reservations meaning you intend to be there unless you specifically indicate prior to the reservation date that you will not be in attendance.




Allies for Teens in Foster Care

This month, our club will be supporting Allies Self-Care Programs, which provides needed hygiene items to teens while also incorporating health and social care discussions. Here are some of the items that are most needed:

- Target Gift Cards \$10 or \$25 increments
- Quality Hygiene Items, including shampoo, conditioner, lotion, deodorant, and tampons.
- Cash donations to be used for:
 - Allies' goal is to start a micro-grant program to provide teens items they need that other school students' parents or guardians provide.


