Hello sister Zontians!



Advocacy



The Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) states, in part, "Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex." On Friday March 5th, U.S. District Judge Rudolph Contreras said that Nevada, Illinois and Virginia's motives were 'laudable' but that they came too late because Congress set deadlines for ratifying the ERA long ago. The Attorneys-General of those three states had sought to force the federal government to recognize Virginia's vote last year to ratify the ERA and add it to the Constitution. Virginia had become the 38th state to ratify the amendment but Congress had enacted a ratification deadline for the ERA that expired decades ago.

In response, Virginia Attorney General Mark Herring stated "Unfortunately, today's decision requires women to continue waiting. Though I'm disheartened by this decision, all women can rest assured that, regardless of this court's decision, my fight for your equal rights does not end today, tomorrow, or any day."

UN Report



Zonta International is passionate about providing life-changing opportunities for women and girls through international service. By partnering with agencies of the United Nations and other recognized non-governmental organizations, Zonta has improved women's health, provided better economic opportunities and prevented gender-based violence in 66 countries. Since our first service project, Zonta has contributed more than US\$32.7 million to our international service projects.

2020-2022 INTERNATIONAL SERVICE PROJECTS

Adolescent Girls' Health and Protection in Peru

\$1,000,000 UNICEF USA

The Adolescent Girls' Health and Protection project will contribute to guaranteeing the rights of indigenous and rural adolescents, especially girls, and respond to their needs by preventing pregnancy, addressing mental health concerns and providing a protective environment from violence by providing quality, gender-sensitive, and culturally adapted health, education and protection services.

Strengthening Response to GBV Survivors in Papua New Guinea and Timor-Leste

\$1,000,000 UNFPA

We are ensuring that all women and girls in Papua New Guinea and Timor-Leste live life free from violence and providing quality services to those who experience violence.

Let Us Learn Madagascar

\$2,000,000 since 2016 \$500,000 2020-2022-Phase III UNICEF USA

We are creating opportunities for vulnerable and excluded children, particularly girls, in Madagascar to realize their right to an education.

Ending Child Marriage

\$1,500,000 UNFPA-UNICEF

We are protecting the rights of millions of vulnerable girls and putting an end to this global violation of human rights in 12 countries in Africa and Asia.

Zonta has supported ending child marriage since 2014, contributing US\$2 million to delay early marriage in Niger from 2014-2018. From 2018-2020, Zonta contributed US\$2 million to the UNFPA-UNICEF Global Program to End Child Marriage. In 2020, Zonta International announced an additional commitment of US\$1,500,000 to UNICEF USA to support Phase II of the Global Program through 2022.

Female Firsts – Amazing WI Women



Colonel Adria Zuccaro became the first woman Commander of the 128th Air Refueling Wing of the Wisconsin National Guard in September 2020. Colonel Zuccaro is a pilot who has flown over 3,000 hours and served in support of Operations Northern Watch, Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, Inherent Resolve and Freedom's Sentinel. Her many leadership positions include executive officer to the Commander of First Air Force in the 601st Air and Space Operations Center at Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida. Colonel Zuccaro currently lives in Whitefish Bay, WI.

Zonta Club of Milwaukee's Ernestine O'Bee

A highlight of the mid-1960s was the induction of **Ernestine O'Bee**, a graduate of the University of Michigan, into the Club. Not only was Ernestine the first African-American member of our Club, she was also the first African-American member in the United States. In addition, in 1952, she became the first woman licensed as a mortician in Wisconsin. She also served as the first woman appointed to the State Board of Examiners for Funeral Directors and Embalmers. Ernestine continued to serve in Zonta until her death in 2007 at age 99.
